| 1. MUSCAT / CHENIN BLANC<br>ANGELS TEARS, SOUTH AFRICA<br>A deliciously, fruity white with upfront honey and spicy flavours on the nose followed by tropical fruit flavours on the palate.  | £2.60 | £4.85 | £13.60 |
| 2. PINOT GRIGIO<br>CA'LUNGHETTA, ITALY<br>An excellent example of Pinot Grigio that is fuller in the mouth than most of Italian Pinot Grigio. This has good weight, minerality and stone fruit flavours on the finish.                          | £2.80 | £5.35 | £15.60 |
| 3. CHARDONNAY<br>COORONG ESTATE AUSTRALIA<br>Enticing aromas of peach and citrus fill the nose. The grapes are picked at optimum ripeness to give a rich, rounded flavour of tropical fruit but balanced out by a crisp, clean finish.          | £2.90 | £5.85 | £16.80 |
| 4. SAUVIGNON BLANC<br>FRANCESCA BAY, NEW ZEALAND<br>Gooseberry and tinned pear with superb crunchy Granny Smith apple and tropical fruit notes.   |       |       | £20.00 |
| 5. PETIT CHABLIS<br>DOMAINE DU COLOMBIER, FRANCE<br>A classic Petit Chablis. The nose is loaded with minerals, citrus and white flower aromas followed by hints of wet stone. Minerally, tight and racy with cool flavours and perfect balance. |       |       | £28.00 |

| 7. MERLOT / CABERNET SAUVIGNON<br>ANGELS TEARS, SOUTH AFRICA<br>Herbaceous cherries and violets on the nose followed by a good medium weight palate.   | £2.60 | £4.85 | £13.60 |
| 8. PINOT NOIR<br>BOUNDARY HUT, NEW ZEALAND<br>Aromatic aromas of fresh mixed red berries with hints of chocolate raisins. This wine is light with a fresh fruit profile and a finely grained tannic structure. | £2.90 | £5.85 | £16.80 |
| 9. MERLOT<br>TORREÓN DE PAREDES, CHILE<br>Aromas of ripe black fruit, cherry and mulberry. The palate is young, fruity, smooth and medium-bodied.  | £2.85 | £5.60 | £16.50 |
| 10. MALBEC<br>MONTAÑÉS, ARGENTINA<br>A nose of spicy mocha underlines the open fruitiness of the Malbec grape. The taste is rich and vibrant with dark red fruits.   |       |       | £18.00 |

| 13. PROSECCO SPUMANTE<br>BAROCCO, ITALY<br>Perfect for any special occasion. It shows a peachy fruit character and a gentle mouthfeel.  |      | £22.00 |
